The mainstream media consistently omits good news and it promotes a false sense of gloom and doom. The truth is, there are plenty of people out there doing good things and creating good news. You may recognize Connie Allar, she's one of our group members and she's one of the people quietly creating good news in her community.

Connie and her family drive every month, from their home in Tijuana, to our support group meetings in Oceanside. After the meetings we load their car with Ostomy supplies to take back across the border. Connie and her family gift the supplies to ostomy patients in Tijuana who don't have access to Ostomy supplies. They've become deeply involved in the Tijuana Ostomy community. Not only are ostomy supplies difficult to come by in Tijuana, but education and support are nonexistent. She is the first person **ever** to address these issues in Tijuana.

February 2nd signified another giant step forward. The first ever Ostomy support group meeting was held in Tijuana, thanks to Connie and her family. I had the pleasure of attending the inaugural meeting, and I admit I was overcome with joy. Connie's compassion and activism for Ostomates in her community was inspiring, impressive and powerful.


